

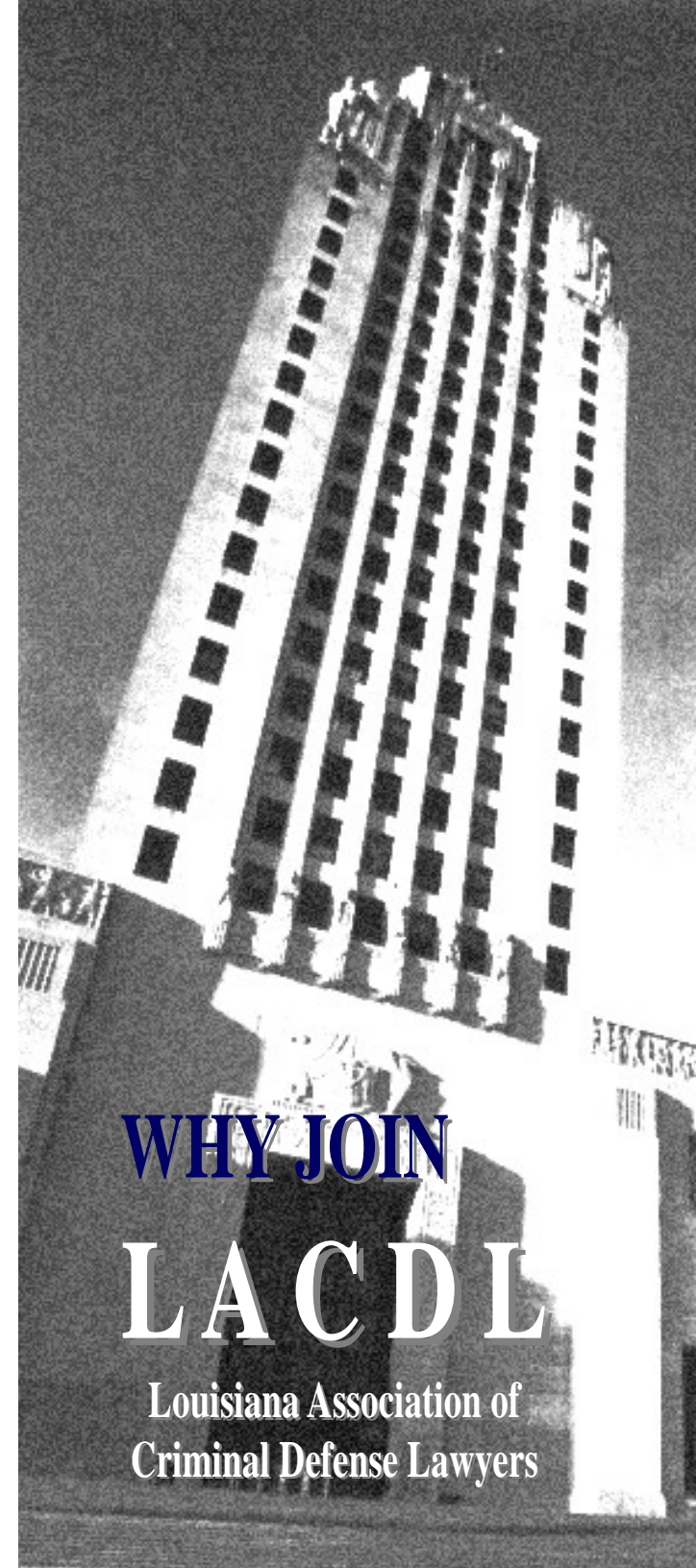
WHO IS LACDL
